
Snapshot of Romanian economy within EU



Within EU, Romania is recording one the lowest GDP per capita, electricity consumption per capita and cars per 1,000 people




- In terms of GDP/capita, Romania ranks second lowest within EU, outranked by Bulgaria who is positioned last. GDP/capita in 2015 was 28% of the EU28 average, at only 8,100 EUR.
- Final electricity/capita at 2,166 MWH/capita ranks Romania last within EU and at only 40% of the EU28 average.
- Romania had 261 passenger cars for every 1000 inhabitants, 52% of the EU 28 average, ranking last within the EU
